Team Building Cardboard Creation

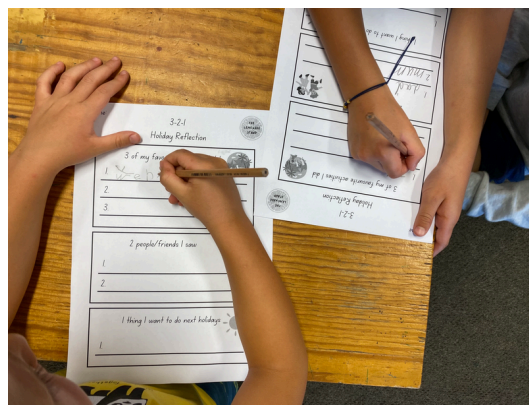
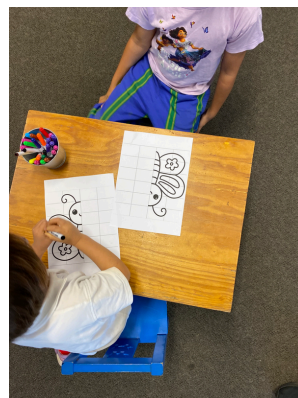
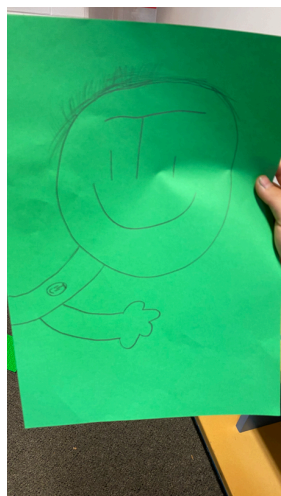

ASC-CLUB ACTIVITIES

Lego Club

Children explore creativity and imagination through building activities using Lego. They can create scenes, models or design their own concepts, encouraging storytelling and innovative thinking. This club supports problem solving skills, collaboration and confidence as children share ideas and work together.



Soccer Club

Children take part in fun, active soccer sessions that include games and skill-building activities such as passing, dribbling and teamwork exercises. The club promotes physical fitness, coordination and overall wellbeing while helping children develop communication skills, teamwork, and self-confidence.



Art Club

Children design and create their own unique llamas, exploring a range of artistic materials, colours, and textures. They are encouraged to think creatively and make individual design choices, supporting imagination and self-expression. This activity also strengthens fine motor skills and attention to detail, while allowing children to take pride in their original creations.



Coding and Robotics

Children are introduced to basic coding concepts and hands-on robotics activities. They explore how to build and program simple models, encouraging curiosity and creativity.
